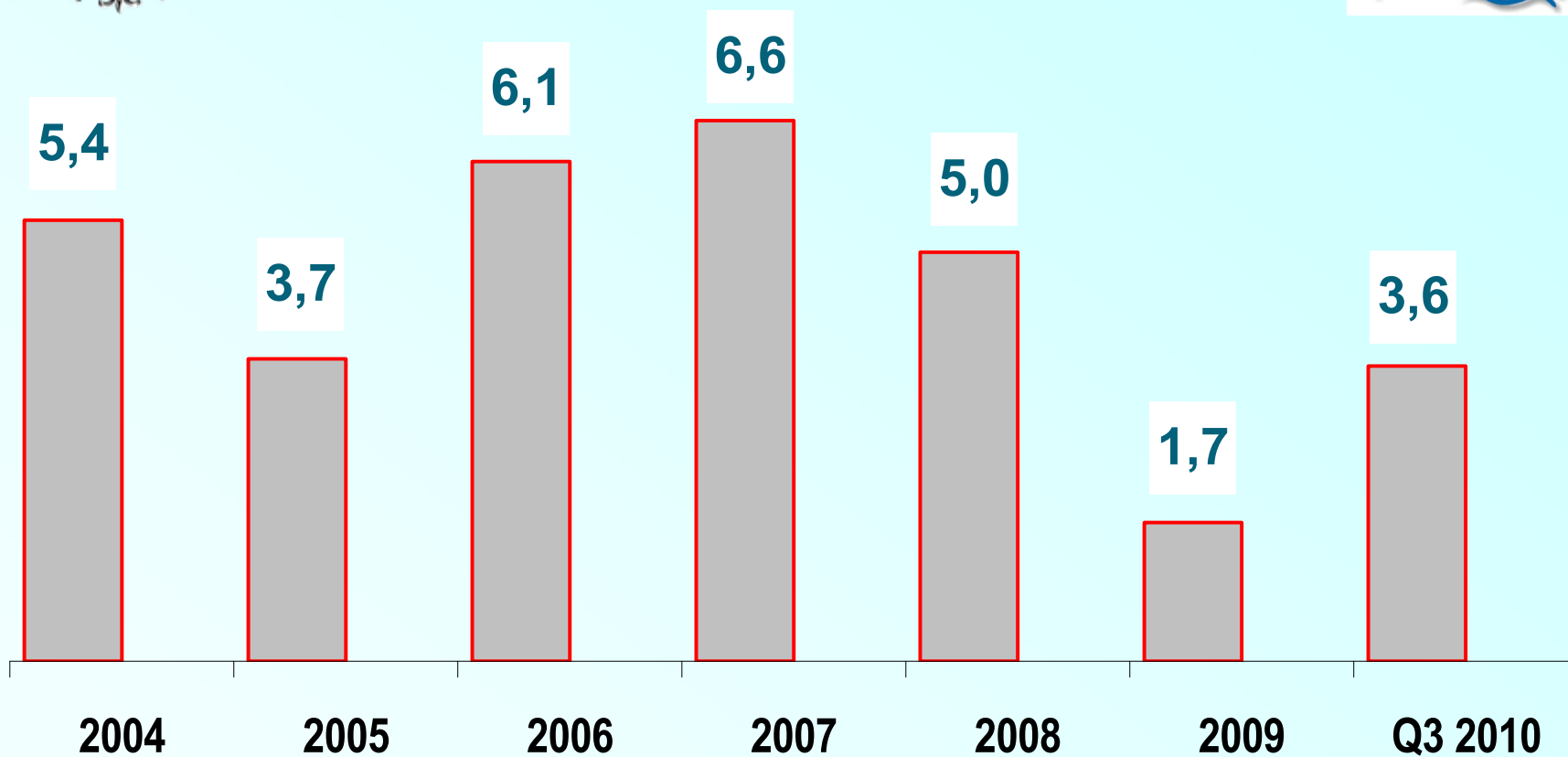

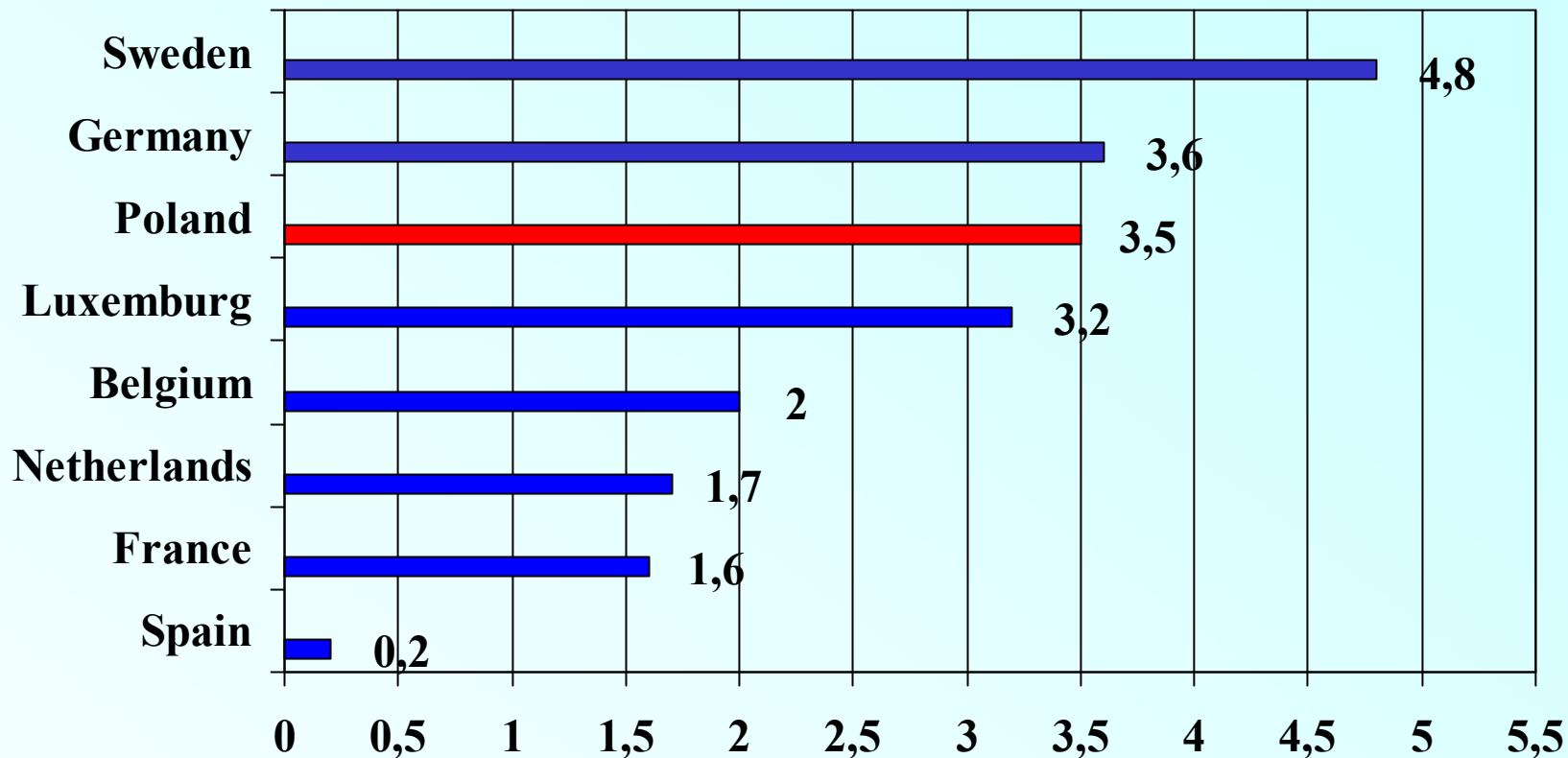


Polish economy in figures – GDP growth





GDP growth in Europe (2010)

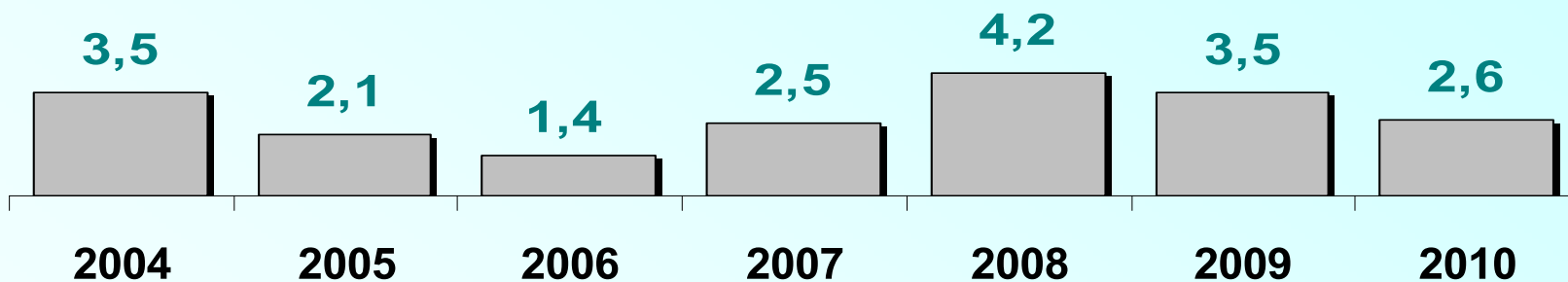

EU 27 average = 1,8%



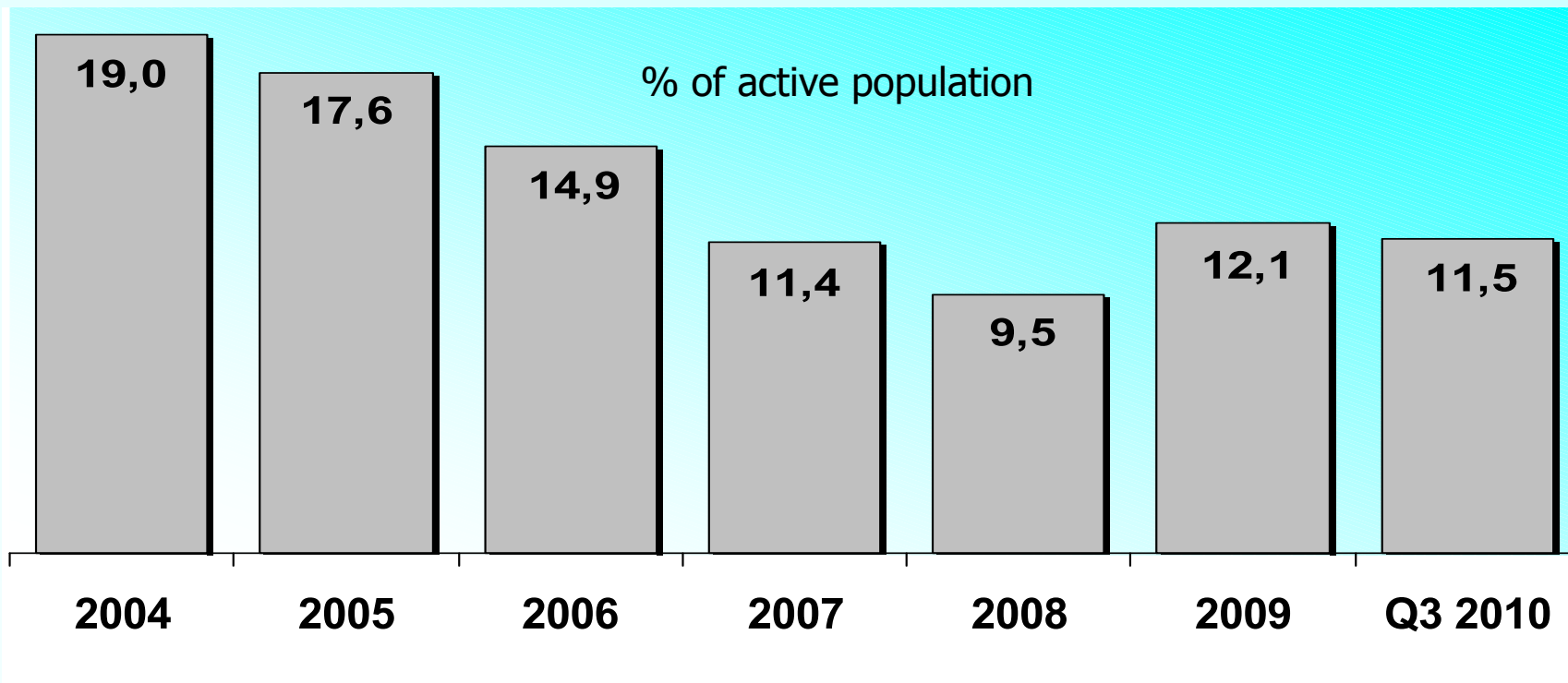
Polish economy in figures – inflation rate

Polish economy in figures – Privatisation



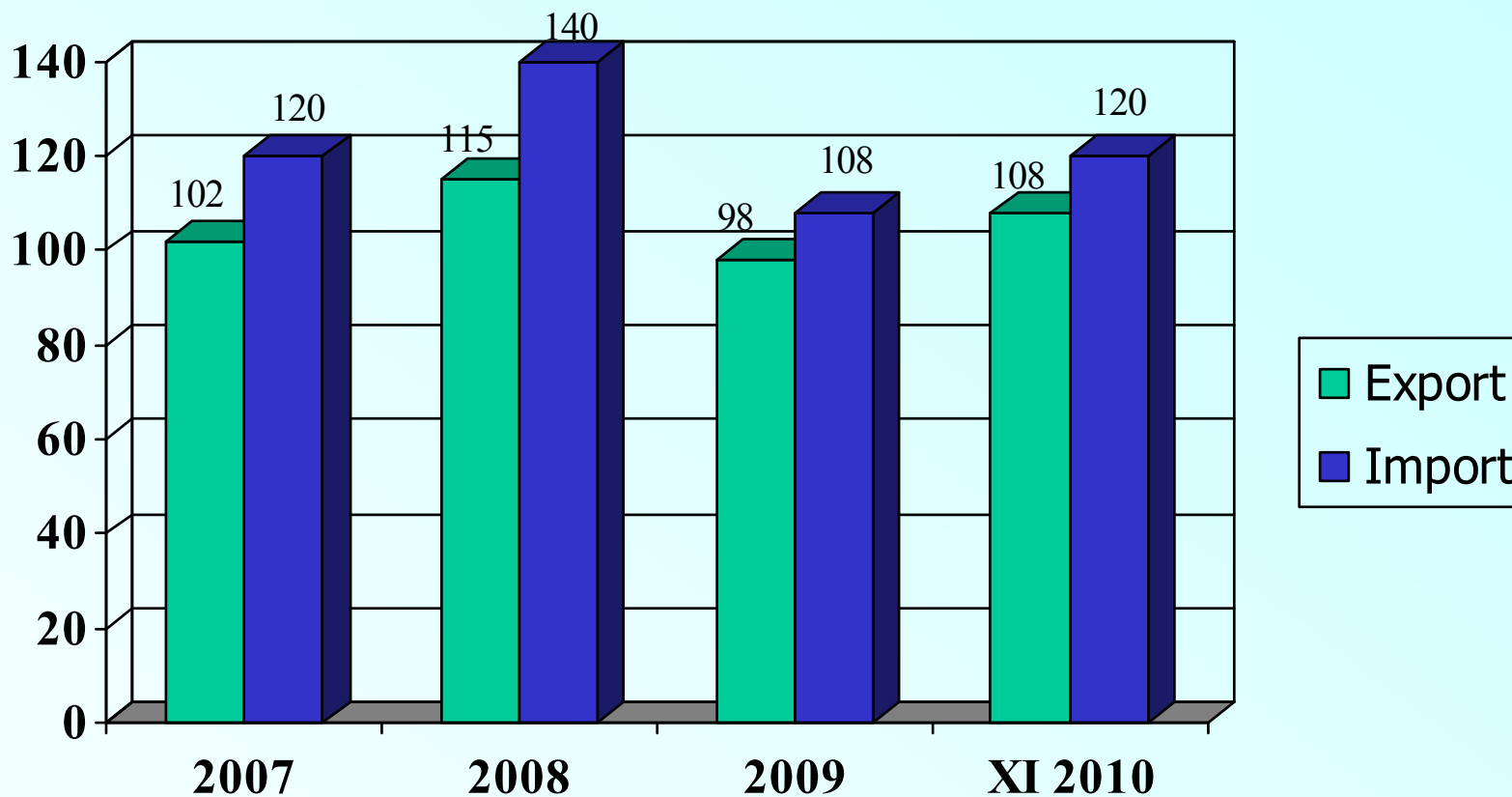
Privatisation revenues in 2010: **PLN 22,037** billion (EUR 5,5 billion)

Largest transactions in 2010:

- **PGE S.A.** (Polish Energy Group) – 10% of shares for PLN 4 billion;
- **KGHM Polska Miedź S.A.** (Polish Copper Company) – 10% of shares for PLN 2 billion;
- **ENEA S.A.** (Energy distribution) – 16,05% of shares PLN 1,13 billion;
- **LW Bogdanka S.A.** (Hard coal mine) – 46,7% of shares for PLN 1,11 billion.
